you are unlawfully present in the United States for more than 180 days but less than one year and depart voluntarily before the start of removal proceedings, you are inadmissible for three years; if you are unlawfully present for one year or more, you are inadmissible for ten years.

**Inadmissibility in General.** If you have concerns about how traveling abroad with the Form I-766 may affect your legal rights, admissibility, or waivers, you should contact an immigration attorney or an immigrant assistance organization accredited by the Board of Immigration Appeals before making foreign travel plans.
