NOTICE TO CONDITIONAL PERMANENT RESIDENT ALIEN



Pursuant to Section 216 of the Immigration and Nationality Act, as amended, you have been granted Conditional Permanent Residence in the United States as of the date you were admitted or adjusted to such status by an officer of the U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services. You and your spouse must file a joint petition (Form I-751) to have the conditional basis of your status removed. The petition must be filed within a ninety (90) day period immediately preceding the second (2nd) anniversary of the date you were accorded conditional permanent resident status. If a petition to remove the conditional basis of your status is not filed within this period, your conditional permanent resident status will be terminated automatically and you will be subject to removal from the United States.

I-751 petitions for minor children who have been accorded conditional permanent resident status must also be filed by their parents within the time frame described above.
