If an alien departs the United States at any time after having accrued more than 180 days of unlawful presence, he or she will be inadmissible as an immigrant, and thus, unable to become a lawful permanent resident, for a period of 3 or 10 years. This ground of inadmissibility may be waived if the alien can demonstrate that the refusal of admission to lawful permanent resident would result in extreme hardship to the U.S. citizen or lawful permanent resident spouse or parent of the alien. Minors, asylees, family unity beneficiaries and battered spouse or children are exempt this ground of inadmissibility.
