Congratulations! Your petition to remove the conditions on residence, form I-751 has been approved.


A Permanent Resident Card ("PRC") will be mailed to you within 90 days to your address shown above.

If you have an **emergent** immediate and justifiable need to travel outside the United States and cannot wait to receive your PRC, you may obtain temporary evidence of your lawful permanent residence by making an **InfoPass** appointment through [www.uscis.gov](http://www.uscis.gov) and appearing at a USCIS office with this letter and a valid, unexpired passport. You will be required to present documentation to justify your departure from the U.S. Examples may include plane tickets, a doctor's letter describing the critical condition of a family member abroad or a written order assigning you overseas.

*If you have a change of address after your I-751 petition is approved but before you receive your Permanent Resident Card, you must complete Form AR-11, Alien's Change of Address Card. Mail the form to: U. S. Department of Homeland Security, United States Citizenship and Immigration Services, Change of Address, P. O. Box 7134, London, KY 40742-7134. For commercial overnight or fast freight services, only: U.S. Department of Homeland Security, Bureau of Citizenship and Immigration Services, Change of Address, 1084-I South Laurel Road, London, KY 40744*

Once again, congratulations on becoming a lawful permanent U.S. resident.
