You must surrender your alien registration card (and any United States travel documents) at this appointment. Bring this notice, your alien registration card (and travel documents), and if your alien registration card was issued more than ten years ago, recent legal photo identification (i.e. a driver's license or passport) to the appointment. Please be advised, proper identification is also required to enter the building.


If for any reason you cannot keep this appointment, return this letter immediately to the USCIS office address listed below with your explanation and request for a new appointment. USCIS will schedule your new oath ceremony appointment for the next available date.

USCIS is committed to providing customers with disabilities the same level of access to its programs and activities that customers without disabilities have (see the USCIS Web site for an explanation and examples of accommodations).
