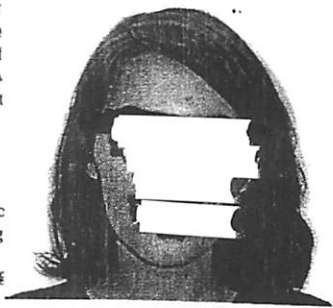

You are authorized to stay in the U.S. only until the date without permission from Department of Homeland Security. **Surrender this permit when you leave the U.S.:**

- By sea or air, to the transportation line;
- Across the Canadian border, to a Canadian Official;
- Across the Mexican border, to a U.S. Official
