

ORDER: Upon consideration by the District Director, and in accordance with Title 8, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 103.5(a) the previous decision dated February 6, 2019 is reopened or reconsidered for review.

DISCUSSION: The record indicates that on August 7, 2018, the petitioner filed an I-130, Petition for Alien Relative, on behalf of the beneficiary, pursuant to Section 201(b) of the Immigration and Nationality Act, as amended. The petition was denied on February 6, 2019, because the petitioner failed to appear for a scheduled interview.

CONCLUSION: The petitioner has provided additional evidence in order to overcome the grounds for denial. The Service will allow the petitioner to continue with the application process.

IT IS ORDERED: The Form I-130 (Petition for Alien Relative) is reopened and the adjudication process is continued regarding petition for alien relative pursuant to Section 245 of the INA.

Additionally, the applicant is eligible to apply for employment authorization in accordance with Title 8, Code of Federal Regulations § 274a.12(c)(9).
