MOTION TO REOPEN/RECONSIDER

U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) has reviewed the decision on your Forms I-130 and I-485 (MSC1 [REDACTED] and MSC1 [REDACTED] respectively), Petition for Alien Relative and Application to Register Permanent Residence or Adjust Status, which you filed with USCIS concurrently on 02/04/2019. As required by Title 8 Code of Federal Regulations (8 CFR) section 103.5, USCIS is notifying you that the following action will be taken:

ORDER

Upon consideration by the Field Office Director, and in accordance with Title 8, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 103.5(a) the previous decision dated 09/03/2019 will be reopened for review.

DISCUSSION

Your petition and application were denied on 09/03/2019 for the petitioner's failure to establish the claimed relationship and for there being no underlying petition on which to base the I-485 upon respectively. The service reviewed the information you submitted with your form I-290B and has concluded there is a basis for reopening the denied forms.

CONCLUSION

After consideration of the law, regulations and policy guiding USCIS, it is concluded that the decision dated 09/03/2019, was not issued in error, but will be reopened.
